Please visit the New Mexico Secretary of State homepage at <https://www.sos.state.nm.us/> to find very important information about voting.

Click on “Voting and Elections”, then click on “Voter Information Portal.” From there you can check on the status of your registration to confirm you are still registered to vote, you can confirm your political party information, and request an Absentee Ballot Application.

The most important thing to know for voters who will be using an absentee ballot for the 2020 General Election is that **you should mail your completed ballot back to your county clerk no later than October 27th** to ensure it arrives before 7:00 pm on Election Day. If you wish to return your absentee ballot in person, please visit <https://www.sos.state.nm.us/> for ballot drop-off locations.

Also, please be advised that Early Voting locations open in each county beginning on Saturday, October 17, 2020 and continue through Saturday, October 31, 2020.
